If you already have a Will, the easiest way you can include a gift to Kidney Research UK is by writing a codicil, which is a short legal document that alters your Will to reflect your new wishes. You can make any number of codicils to amend an existing Will.

Simply fill in this form in the presence of **two witnesses** (who must be adults, unrelated to you, and not benefiting from your Will). **In order to include a gift to Kidney Research UK, make sure you keep the codicil with your Will so your executors can find it.**
